

Are you attending **Stimulus 2018** and currently prescribed Opioid Agonist Treatment?

eg. methadone, Suboxone®, or SROM/Kadian®

Metro City Medical Clinic and **Downtown Prescription Centre** have partnered with Stimulus 2018 to assist with maintenance treatment for attendees! Located around the corner from the Coast Edmonton Plaza (AAWEAR and CAPUD Host Hotel), we are only a 15-minute walk to the Shaw Conference Centre (conference location).

What We Need

- **Your demographic information**, including name, address, phone number, date of birth, any medication or food allergies, and a list of medications you are currently taking
- **Your regular pharmacy's name and phone number**, in case we need to call to confirm your previous medication history
- **A valid prescription**
 - If possible, have it faxed directly from your prescriber to us in advance
 - Please ask your prescriber to include their provincial license number, as well as their clinic contact information
- **Your prescription drug coverage information**
 - If you can fax a photocopy of your coverage card ahead of time, that's great. Otherwise, bring it with you to the pharmacy.
 - Note: Most out-of-province, public drug plans (eg. BC Pharmacare, Ontario Drug Benefit, others) **cannot** be direct-billed in Alberta. In this case, you may need to pay for your medication when you pick it up, and submit the receipts when you get home.

The earlier we receive this information, the easier it is to minimize any delays in getting you your medication. If your prescriber has any questions, they can call us directly to discuss.

What about the cost?

Cost can vary based on a number of factors: medication, dosage, prescription drug coverage, and whether or not you are picking up carried doses, for example. Once we receive your prescription, we would be happy to discuss the cost with you directly.
